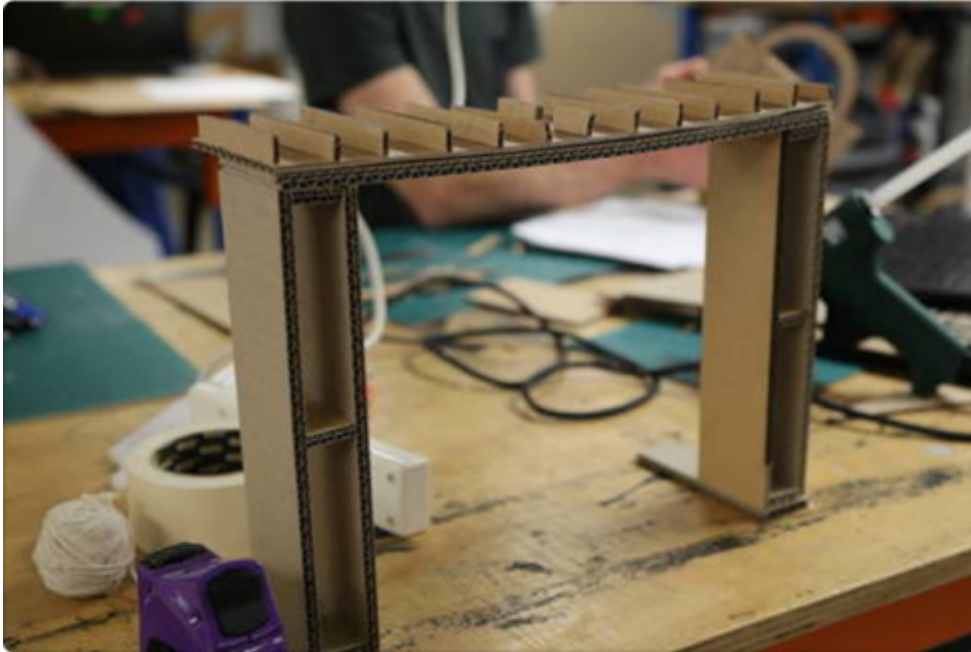

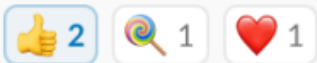
@Diane The design hidden by the brief had a zigzag mouth. I think it looked more upset then mad.
