Web Browsers

A web browser is a type of software that allows you to find and view websites on the Internet. Even if you didn't know it, you're using a web browser right now to read this page! There are many different web browsers, but some of the most common ones include **Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Safari, Microsoft Edge, and Mozilla Firefox.**



Search Engines

With billions of websites online today, there is a **lot** of information on the Internet. **Search engines** make this information easier to find.

There are many different search engines you can use, but some of the most popular include [Google](#), [Yahoo!](#), and [Bing](#).



Performing a Search Using Google

- Search terms are based on keywords
- Keep search terms simple and be aware of Australian/American spelling, plurals, synonyms etc.
- Google predict, spelling mistakes, searching phrases and how to exclude words in a search.
- Advanced search and using limiters
