## **Trainer's Session Plan**

Time: 2 ½ hours

## About the session

This training session is about gaining skills and understanding of family history services, resources and concepts to get started in family history research. This program will outline resources available at your local public library and through other organisations to assist in family history research. Ancestry Library Edition is made available to every public library in Queensland for onsite use through State Library funding. Ancestry Library Edition is made up of billions of records. The training session also includes information about accessing Trove digitised newspapers a free service hosted by National Library of Australia.

**Learning Intention:** To search and browse *Ancestry Library Edition* and *Trove* digitised newspapers with confidence.

**Equipment:** Laptop, projector, screen or wall for projection, internet connection, print out of participant guides. Participants can bring along a laptop or tablet to follow the session.
