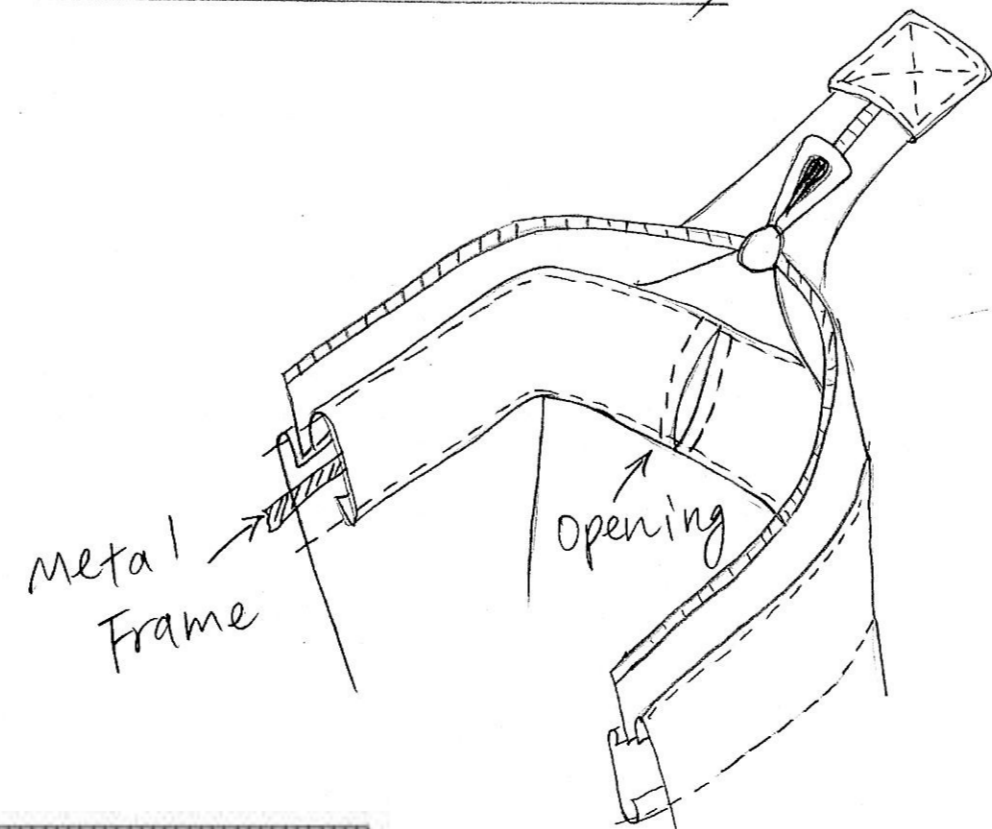
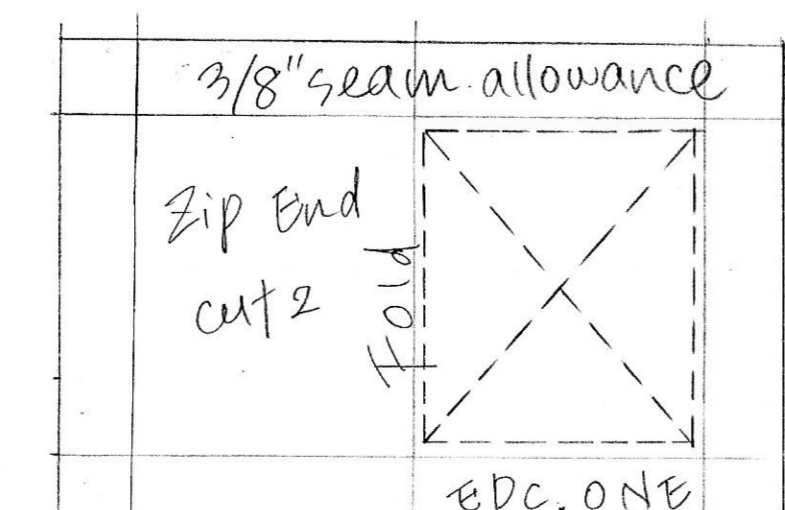
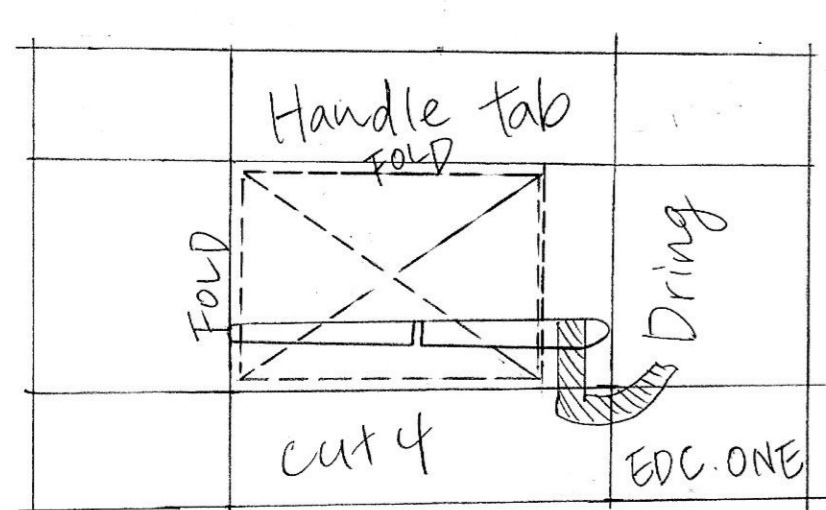
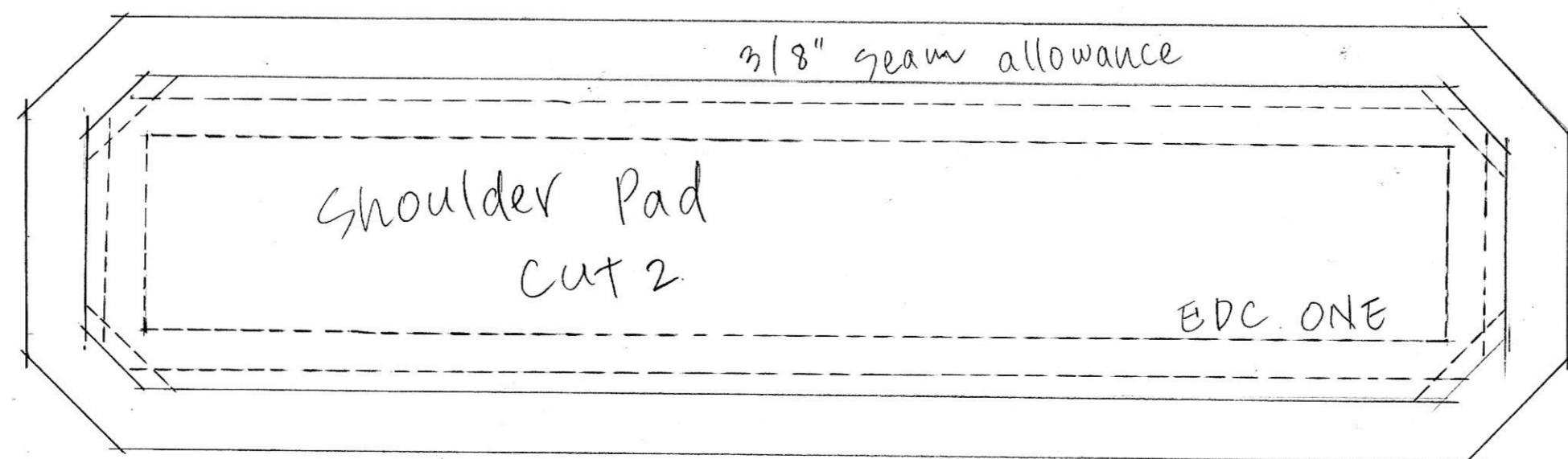
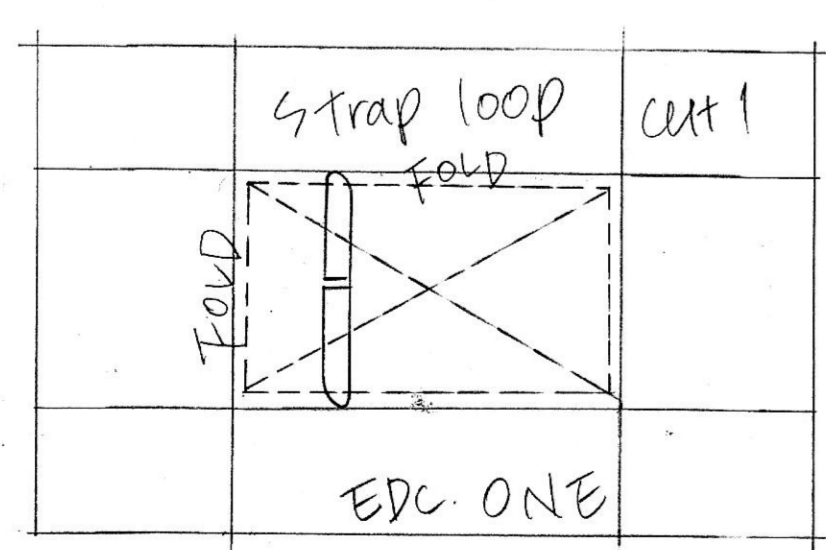
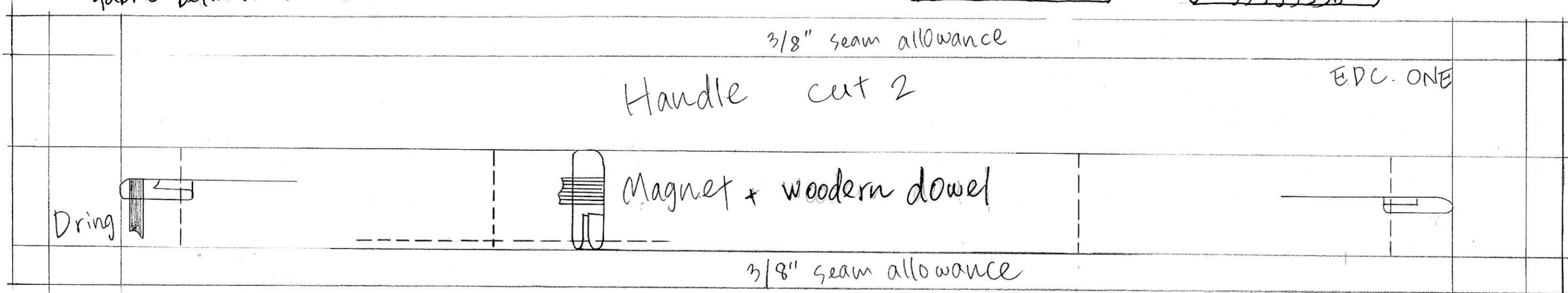
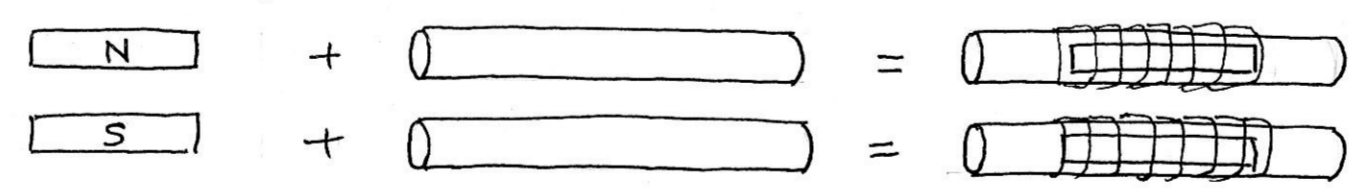


- What you need
- Set fabric
 - Lining
 - 27" long continuous zipper with two sliders meeting in the middle
 - 4 Rings
 - 2 of lobster clasps
 - 1 webbing slide
 - 70" of 1" wide hook & loop
 - One pair of magnet
 - 2 wooden dowels
 - 60" of 1" wide webbing
 - Plastic board (9 3/4" x 15")
 - One pair of metal frame
 - 5" of 3/4" wide webbing

Preparation

- Cut all parts (1/2" seam allowances are included, unless otherwise noted)
- Attach 7 of 9" long hook & loops to the bottom (lining only), and 2 of 3 1/2" long hook & loops to the front main panel.
- Attach the main panel B to the main panel A, and the side panel B to the side panel A.
- Attach the pen holder to the pocket first, then attach to the main panel (lining)
- Make two handles - A. insert the magnets & wooden dowels to the middle of handles B. attach to the main panel with Rings
- Attach the strap loop to the main panel
- Attach zip ends to both ends of zipper

- 1) Separate magnets
- * Warning! Magnets may break if they snap together without fabric between them.
- How to set up 2 magnet dowels
- 2) Attach the magnets to the wooden dowels and tape together.



Construction Steps

1. Sew main and side panels together to form a tube.
2. Place the bottom of the bag, and sew all the way around.
3. Do the same with the lining fabric.
4. Sandwich the plastic bottom between the outer and the inner bottom, then sew all edges together.
5. Turn the outer bag the right way out. Drop the lining into the outer bag, and pin the both opening together.
6. Attach the zipper to the opening
7. Insert the metal frame through the side opening.
